

Central Seat Allocation Board (CSAB-2018)
CSABNEUT – 2018

Subject:-

(1) Process and schedule to accommodate the provision of **one time relaxation** in eligibility condition regarding 12th class marks for the candidates who secured at least 45% marks (40% for SC/ST) in 12th class for CSAB-NEUT counselling [Ref: MHRD Notification (F.No.19-1/2018-TC) dated 06th July 2018]

(2) Procedure for **SPOT Round** of CSAB NEUT 2018

Vide the above mentioned order of MHRD, it has been directed to provide a one-time relaxation in eligibility condition regarding 12th class marks for the candidates who secured at least 45% marks (40% for SC/ST) in 12th class in admission against the degree level supernumerary seats in CSAB-NEUT counselling for North Eastern States and UT students, for the academic session 2018-19.

To accommodate the above provision, following will be the modalities of Spot round:

(i) Relaxed criteria for CSAB-NEUT counselling (as per MHRD notification and as per CSAB/JoSAA rules as applicable, i.e. 45% marks (40% for SC/ST) for Engg and 50% for BArch/BPlan irrespective of category) would be made applicable after both ongoing regular rounds of CSAB NEUT 2018, i.e. during Spot Round. (For admission to B.Arch/B.Plan, relaxed eligibility condition regarding 12th class marks would be 50% as was in CSAB-2017 and as per the requirement of CoA).

(ii) The allotment in spot round will be done by respective DTEs as per their approved business rules, available in the Brochure at www.csab.nic.in under CSAB NEUT section. The conversions (de-reservation) of seats from one category to another (if permitted in the Business Rules) will be done as per the prescribed norms during the Spot round only (if seats are vacant after 2nd round). Candidates are advised to get in touch with DTEs for dates of spot round.

(iii) The spot round is an offline process and no online registration is required by the candidates. They have to report to the DTE/RC as per the schedule to be notified by respective DTEs along with all necessary documents (original and self-attested photocopy) mentioned in the Brochure and as asked by DTE.

(iv) All eligible candidates, whether they registered or not (i.e. new candidates) for CSAB NEUT 1st round, whether any seat allotted or not from 1st/2nd Round, whether reported to RC or not, can participate in the spot round (although it is not mandatory for students who have been allotted a seat in round 1 or 2 to participate in spot round). However, those candidates who have a confirmed seat allotment under CSAB NEUT 2018, with provisional admission letter issued by DTE/RC from 1st / 2nd Rounds, cannot participate in Spot Round **unless** they Withdraw their currently allotted seat. (Withdrawal must be done in the dedicated time frame (i.e. Aug 01-03 2018) through the online portal on the website www.csab.nic.in under NEUT section). Once the currently allotted seat is withdrawn/surrendered, the claim of the candidate on the withdrawn seat will be lost, irrespective of whether a seat is subsequently allotted in the Spot round or not.

(v) Those candidates who withdraw their confirmed seat (i.e. having valid provisional admission letter issued by DTE/RC from 1st / 2nd Rounds after successful reporting) allotted under CSABNEUT 2018, through the online withdrawal portal in the prescribed time window before the spot round, an amount of Rs 2000/- (out of Rs 3000/- processing fee deposited by the candidate in the form of DD in the name of *MNIT Jaipur CSAB 2018* at the time of reporting at RC during 1st or 2nd round) will be refunded to the candidate. This refund will be made by CSAB at the end of counselling process in the candidates' bank account (and not by DTE/RC).
